Membership Qualifications

Senior Active Member

Is a woman twenty-one years of age or over who pays full dues. A Senior Active Member may vote, sponsor nominees for Senior Active Membership, be elected to the Club's Board of Trustees and hold office.

Senior Introductory Member

Senior Members who were not Senior Members within the past 12 months qualify for a one-time only introductory rate. At the end of 12 months, the membership will be reviewed at the current Senior rate.

Junior Active Member

Is a woman twenty-one years of age or over but less than forty years of age before September 1st, or age notwithstanding, a woman with children twelve years of age or under, who pays dues. A Junior Active Member has Club privileges but may not vote nor be elected to serve on the Board of Trustees.

Men's Associate Member

Is a man, twenty-one years of age or over, who pays dues. Men's Associate Members may use the dining rooms and participate in Club activities with guest privileges, but may not vote or hold office.

Dining Member

An individual twenty-one years of age or older who is employed full time (at least 32 hours a week) and pays dues. A Dining Member may have dining privileges for all meals, attend special events and other Club functions but may attend Sections only as a guest on guest days. A Dining Member may sponsor nominees for Dining Membership. A Dining member shall not vote or hold office.
